Scholarship Criteria

Applicants must:

- 1. Be residents of Illinois and pursuing a nursing career through an ADN or BSN degree program;
- 2. Have proof of acceptance for enrollment, or proof of enrollment in an approved ADN or BSN nursing program plus completion of one nursing course in the nursing program;
- 3. Have and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in nursing courses;
- 4. Provide an official copy of school transcripts and proof of current registration;
- 5. Provide evidence of participation in school or civic activities, i.e., student government, a nursing organization, church, community health fair, or tutoring of other students;
- 6. Submit a minimum of a 500 word-essay (typewritten) discussing values, career goals, financial needs and how this grant will benefit your school performance;
- Obtain at least two letters of recommendation written on official letterhead of the institution or organization (one of which must be from a nursing faculty, and the other from another faculty or community/civic organization);
- 8. Participate in one of the following voluntary activities held by: either the Chicago Chapter National Black Nurses Association; Alpha Eta Chapter of Chi Eta Phi Sorority, Inc; Beta Mu Chapter of Lambda Pi Alpha Sorority; or Provident Hospital Nurses' Alumni Association during the 2017 year.
