Scholarship Eligibility:

- 1) Applicants must be a resident of Illinois
- 2) Must submit a copy of current RN License
- 3) Must submit proof of active employment in the Long Term Setting or Psychiatric Setting.
- 4) Must have proof of acceptance for enrollment in an approved advanced practice-nursing program and/or must be enrolled and have completed one nursing course with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A.
- 5) Submit a minimum 500 word typed essay inclusive of financial need and/or provide any additional evidence why you are deserving of CCNBNA Scholarship. A current photo must be included in profile.
- 6) Must participate in CCNBNA sponsored health care events after acceptance.
- 7) Become an active member of the Chicago Chapter National Black Nurses Association.
- 8) Obtain at least two letters of recommendation, in which one must be from a discipline of Nursing, and the other one can be submitted from a community organization, current employer, civic organization, and/or professor of education.
- 9) Submitted letter (s) of recommendation must be written on official letterhead of institution and/or organization.
